
PAES PEG BOARD TOOL WALL EXAMPLES




Typically the school maintenance staff will build a tool wall for your lab. Either way, the shopping list is quite simple:

- One Piece of Pegboard 4' X 8' (can be smaller)
- Five Pine 1"x2"x8" boards to use as framing
- Screws
- Tool Hooks (use your actual tools to make a shopping list of what tool hooks to purchase)

Example of ULINE storage cabinet for storing other construction tools, simulators and supplies.

Notice the metal and wood vice are installed across from each other. This is so both left and right handed workers can use both vices.
