
## IDEA FOR STAND UP WORK TABLES FOR PAES Purchased Through ULINE


Depending on what you have available for existing work tables, countertops, and storage cabinets, you may find that you want to order more counter height work tables for your PAES lab. One option would be ordering packing tables from ULINE. This is the same brand of work bench table that comes with the PAES lab.

They are inexpensive, and come with built in storage shelf below. You can also order under counter mounted drawers for extra storage. You can order the standard composite tops, or you can upgrade to a laminate, steel or other surfaces for the "stand-up" business marketing and processing and production

jobs. If your budget allows, you can upgrade to a stainless steel top for consumer services cooking station.

## ULINE TABLE TOP OPTIONS



Note: The composite wood edges are rough. There are a few steps you can take to remove the rough edges from your composite wood packing table tops.


- Start with light sanding using 120-150 grit sandpaper to remove rough edges.
- After it's fairly smooth, use 800 grit sandpaper until very smooth.
- Coat with high quality polyurethane, matte finish lacquer (Minwax) using a brushed application.

\* The work bench that comes with PAES is a 60" X 30" ULINE packing table with a composite board top.

There are four options to install the wood and metal vises that come with your PAES shipment to the work bench shown below in green.

Often times building maintenance staff will install these for you.

Our 2 labs had to get creative and reuse/ repurpose a lot of tables instead of buying them new when we started last September. Here are some photos of how our incredible maintenance man made it work! We reused and elevated an old conference/ board room table, a few computer tables, and even located some stainless steel work cabinets that weren't being utilized. The last 2 pictures are other ways we dealt with a money shortage. We found a salvaged countertop piece and had a local Craftsman build us a long table to fit 2 students side-by-side. He donated his labor and that helped keep it costs down. Lastly, we got a grant from Harbor Freight for 2 workbenches (I'd highly recommend it!), along with a few extra tools.
