PAES is.....

- about helping students become as independent as possible.
- **not** a classroom.
- a job where students become employees and teachers become supervisors.
- a measure of employment potential and job interests.
- a guide to the transition planning process for both in school and community options.
- customizable to a student's age and level of need.

PAES Employees.....

- perform many of the same types of jobs found in the community.
- explore 264 jobs spread throughout 5 different industry types (called components).
- tend to find out they can do things they didn't know they could do before PAES.
- often surprise parents, caregivers, and teachers with all they accomplish in the lab.
- learn workplace "soft skills" and are rewarded for appropriate workplace behaviors.
- are provided scaffolded supports through the use of job subtasks when needed.

Also.....

- The PAES assessment gives clear and definitive answers to transition related questions by *providing detailed* <u>reports</u> that build a profile of job performance and workplace skills.
- The PAES Summary of Performance reports generalize to the expectations of a variety of employment options and can be shown to outside agencies and/or potential employers.
