



Ideas for Construction Tool Storage

Peg Board Tool Wall Examples



Typically the school maintenance staff will build a tool way for your lab. Either way, the shopping list is quite simple.


Pegboard Tool Wall Shopping List:

- One sheet of pegboard 4 X 8' (can be cut down if smaller size is needed)
- Five pine 1 X 2'X 8' boards to use for framing
- Screws
- Tool Hooks (use your actual tools to make your list)

Work Bench with Wood & Metal Vices



Notice the metal and wood vice are installed across from each other. This is so both left and right handed workers can use both vices.
